## Second Transnational Meeting in Klaipeda, Lithuania

The second Transnational Partner Meeting for the "SEA4SHORE" project was held in Klaipeda, Lithuania, graciously hosted by LAJM (Lithuanian Maritime Academy). Representatives from RTU (Latvia), Maritime Innovators (Turkey), Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya (Spain), IDEC S.A. (Greece), and the University of Rijeka (Croatia) came together to review the project's progress and outline key tasks for the upcoming period.

The SEA4SHORE project is committed to facilitating the transition of experienced seafarers into shore-based careers. To achieve this, the project focuses on developing a competency map and an online tool that will guide maritime professionals in discovering new career opportunities on land. This initiative aims to provide valuable support to seafarers who possess extensive sea-based experience but may lack information about available options ashore.

By taking a transnational approach, SEA4SHORE seeks to enhance the recognition of seafarers' skills in shore-based roles and boost their career mobility across Europe. The project's tools will enable a smoother transition for maritime professionals, helping them leverage their expertise and explore new paths.
