SEA4SHORE Partnership Moves Forward at the Fourth Partner Meeting in Rijeka

The SEA4SHORE partnership gathered in Rijeka, Croatia, on 25–26 September 2025 for the Fourth Partner Meeting, hosted by the University of Rijeka. Partners reviewed the project's progress and set clear goals for the final implementation phase.

During the meeting, partners discussed:

- Continuous updates to the SEA4SHORE Platform (www.sea4shore.com), which now features project news, outputs, and partner contributions.
- Finalisation of the Tool Specifications and development of the Online Career Guidance Tool, designed to help seafarers transition from sea to shore.
- Testing and design of the User Interface to ensure accessibility and usability.
- Ongoing discussions on Accreditation, ensuring quality recognition at national and EU levels.

The project now moves into its most active dissemination and piloting phase, preparing for national events and the final conference in early 2026.

"SEA4SHORE is about creating real opportunities for seafarers," said Ugurcan Acar, Coordinator of Maritime Innovators.
